

Open Call

“FLAD – Visiting Professor at Brown University 2022/2023”

The Luso-American Development Foundation and the Department of Portuguese and Brazilian Studies at Brown University (Providence, Rhode Island, USA) announce an open call for Visiting Professorship opportunities. This call seeks to select two professors, one per semester, for the academic year 2022/2023.

MAIN OBJECTIVE

To teach a semester-long course in English on History or Social Sciences (sociology, anthropology, political science) related to contemporary Portugal. The theme of the course can encompass the Portuguese speaking communities and/or include an international comparative dimension. The final decision on the topic will result from discussions between Brown’s Department of Portuguese and Brazilian Studies and the selected candidate.

It is expected that the selected candidates are willing to cooperate with FLAD’s general objectives at Brown, as well as with other higher education institutions in the New England Area.

LENGTH OF STAY

A Visiting Professor will be selected for each of the following academic semesters:

- Fall semester (September-December) of 2022
- Spring Semester (January-May) of 2023.

REQUIREMENTS

- Complete PhD at the time of the application
- Affiliation with a higher education institution in Portugal and/or be an integrated member or collaborator of an R&D unit recognized by the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology
- Teaching experience in English

Individual applications will be accepted according to the following requirements (in English):

- Motivation Letter;
- CV (including academic publications and teaching experience)
- Copy of PhD certificate
- Two recommendation letters from professionals within the academic field (faculty or researcher)
- Course proposal intended to be offered at Brown University
- Semester preference
- Consent under the General Data Protection Regulation

Note: Both recommendation letters can be submitted in Portuguese or English. All other documents should be submitted in English.

If necessary the jury will conduct interviews with the best qualified candidates.

The application period, for both semester positions, will run from September 14 to Nov 6, 2021.

Results will be announced until November 30, 2021.
