



Message from Greece - CYA - 2016 & 2024 Europeans hosts

In October 2024, CYA hosted the Forum on Education Abroad's 2024 Careers, Internships, and Global Learning (CIGL) Conference and the 7th Europe, Middle East, and Africa (EMEA) Conference. CYA invested considerable financial and human resources to ensure the event's success. CYA staff & faculty presented a session, and attended many sessions, gaining valuable insights into best practices and emerging trends in international education. This contributed significantly to professional development by equipping the team with new tools and strategies to enhance operations and student support.

Attendee feedback was overwhelmingly positive, resulting in the strengthening of existing partnerships and the establishment of new collaborations.

CYA was honored to be chosen to host the 2016 European Conference as well. While many of the same mechanisms were replicated in 2024, the scale was considerably larger—the audience was three times larger, side activities quadrupled, and the benefits for CYA were substantial. That said, it's still early to fully realize all the fruits of the efforts.
