



1. Institution Overview

Faculdade de Letras – Universidade de Lisboa

The School of Arts and Humanities is the third largest of the eighteen schools of the University of Lisbon and ranked #1 Portuguese Faculty in Humanities. It was founded in 1911, from a course that existed since 1859. Its teaching and research have always focused on the great areas of the humanities: literary studies, philosophy, history and linguistics. Over time these areas were often reconfigured to include new topics of development and interest.

With seven departments in the areas of language science, philosophy, history and literatures, arts and culture, eight programs, ten research centres and four endowed chairs, the school of arts and humanities offers sixteen BA programs (and manages a seventeenth interdisciplinary Ba program offered at the university level), 24 master programs, and 20 PhD programs (some in collaboration with other both national and international institutions).

The School of Arts and Humanities is known to be a place of freedom of thought where programs are designed to enhance the students' ability to think and choose their own path. Our Faculty has some of the great experts in their field both nationally and internationally, people who are transforming Humanities in Portugal. 10% of our Faculty is foreign and we invite every year specialists from top universities throughout the world to teach some classes to our students, giving them the opportunity to meet the authors Whose publications they study. Researchers and Faculty from the School of Arts and Humanities are encouraged to spend time in other institutions outside of Portugal, not only to further research in the humanities, but also to exchange ideas and knowledge in their fields of study.

To those who visit we offer: an outstanding education by experts in the Arts and Humanities; the opportunity to study any subject within the Humanities; the possibility to learn a new language or continue the learning process of over 30 foreign languages including Portuguese; the option of sitting exams to achieve recognized certification in Portuguese as a foreign language; to include research internships in their training; collaboration with our 15 research units; access to our Library, the biggest in Humanities nationwide; and enjoy the experience of being a student of a top European School of Arts and Humanities. As a result, our



international students of over 50 different nationalities account for around 30% of our student community.

Our goal is to provide the best opportunities to those who like to think and debate, who are curious to learn and want to know more. At the School of Arts and Humanities we open up worlds.
