

“Papers@USA Grants” 2027

Grants to support oral presentations of conference papers in the USA

This program aims at supporting the internationalization of scientific knowledge produced in Portugal. Posters presentations will not be accepted.

The individual applicants to the Grants for the Presentation of Papers in Conferences in the United States must meet the following conditions:

- Holding Portuguese Nationality or being residents in Portugal;
- Being proficient in English;
- Being PhD students, lecturers or researchers at Portuguese institutions of higher education and/or research centers;
- Holding the paper (or presentation slides, if the conference does not require the full paper) and the proof of acceptance of the paper by the conference organizers (this document can be sent within 30 days following the close of the call to rafaela.almeida@flad.pt);
- Holding a recommendation letter from the Portuguese Institution to which the applicant is bonded to, supporting the participation in the conference for the oral presentation of the paper;
- Your application CV must not exceed six (6) A4 sheets.

Travel grants awarded up to a maximum amount of 1.200 Euros.

Conferences in the USA beginning:

January 2027: Applications from September 1 to 30, 2026

February 2027: Applications from October 1 to 31, 2026

March 2027: Applications from November 1 to 30, 2026

April 2027: Applications from December 1 to 31, 2026

May 2027: Applications from January 1 to 31, 2027

June 2027: Applications from February 1 to 28, 2027

July 2027: Applications from March 1 to 31, 2027

August 2027: Applications from April 1 to 30, 2027

September 2027: Applications from May 1 to 31, 2027

October 2027: Applications from June 1 to 30, 2027

November 2027: Applications from July 1 to 31, 2027

December 2027: Applications from August 1 to 31, 2027

The results will be published 60 days after the submissions deadline.
